



Waste Management Policy

All Saints' Church, Walsoken

Specific Policy

This Health & Safety (H&S) sub-policy manages waste at church.

Waste from places of religious worship is regarded as domestic waste and is collected by local authorities.

There is little waste in All Saints' Church, Walsoken for routine activities. As church waste is considered domestic waste it can discarded for collection in any domestic waste containers where local authorities collect.

There is no business waste from All Saints' Church, Walsoken.

There is no controlled waste from All Saints' Church, Walsoken.

There are fewer than 10 employees at All Saints' Church, Walsoken so the Simpler Recycling Legislation 2025 does not apply.

Procedure

- 1) All cleaning waste from domestic cleaning products can be discarded in the kitchen bin.
- 2) All sundry food wastes can be discarded in the kitchen bin.
- 3) All paper can be recycled in the "Paper only" bin by the south porch.
- 4) Bins need to be emptied by congregational volunteers with the waste taken so that local authorities can legally collect it.
- 5) If the church or the Tom Walters room is hired, then the hirer is responsible for legal disposal of any waste.
- 6) Contractor waste is under the control of the contractor's waste procedures.
